



SKATE FITTING

Improperly fitted skates is the primary cause of foot discomfort and the reason for poor performance and skate breakdown. To properly fit skates, the following areas of concern must be addressed.

FOOT LENGTH

The Riedell fitting device is the tool used to determine the overall length of the skater's foot and to give an accurate size suggestion. Properly trained skate fitters are recommended for the best individual fit. The Riedell sizing device should not be used as a substitute for an individualized fitting by a trained expert.

The skater's heel should be placed firmly up against the back portion of the measurement device and held in place. The length measurement of the foot should be taken in both a seated and standing position. The furthest point of the longest toe should be noted to indicate length of the foot.

FOOT WIDTH

The proper width selection is critical to the overall comfort of the foot. If a skate boot is fit too narrow or too wide, foot comfort, support and performance can be affected. Choosing the proper width is essential to skater performance and boot longevity.

Riedell models are available in a variety of different widths to accommodate many foot shapes and sizes. Using a cloth tape measure, measure the circumference at the widest portion of the ball of the foot. Pull the measurement tape snugly around the foot. It should be noted that extra care be used when taking this measurement as each boot width changes by ¼" increments. Also remember the foot will expand when weight bearing so comfort in the standing position is critical.

CHOOSING THE CORRECT SIZE AND WIDTH

Once the foot length and width of the skater has been determined, you should reference the skate size and width chart for the proper choice of size and width. To best determine correct size and width we suggest utilizing a trained and knowledgeable skate fitter.

LACING SKATES

In order to get the most benefit from your skates, proper lacing procedure will ensure added foot comfort, support and performance.

Preparing the skate prior to lacing it on your foot will aid in the process and allow you to easily and comfortably secure the skate on your foot.

- 1. In order to allow your foot to get into the boot easily, loosen the laces all the way down to the toe area.
- **2.** Slide your foot into the skate and lightly tap your foot down flat on the floor. This will get your foot solidly down to the base of the skate.
- **3.** Next you should tap your heel back firmly to set your foot all the way into the heel cup of the boot.
- **4.** Starting down at the first eyelet, pull the laces with firm tension to snugly hold the foot in place. By pulling the underside lace first as you progress up the eyelets you will maintain firm pressure and prevent the laces from loosening. Continue this process up over the instep to the ankle.
- **5.** The ankle area is critical to provide the flexion of the foot and boot so by using slightly less tension on the laces from the ankle area to the top will provide flexibility. To increase support of the boot, lacing tighter in this area will add support and decrease flexibility.
- **6.** At the ankle area when lacing around the hooks, it is suggested to wrap the lace around the top of the hook as this will help lock down the lace and keep the tension from loosening.
- **7.** To effectively and securely tie off the laces at the top, it is suggested to put two cross twists in the laces as this will prevent the laces from loosening.

BLADE MOUNTING

Mounting ice skate blades is not a difficult task but does take a little patience and understanding of the basic mounting procedures. The following steps are the simple process we recommend for mounting ice skate blades to the skate boots.

- 1. To determine the proper length blade, measure the overall sole length of the boot from toe to heel. Most blade styles come in $\frac{1}{4}$ " length increments so if the sole measures 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ " in length the proper size blade would be 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ ". It is not suggested the blade length be any shorter than $\frac{1}{4}$ " than the overall length of the sole.
- 2. By examining the sole and the heel bottom of the boot, find the center portion of the sole and heel. You can put a light pencil mark at the toe and heel at the center point for location, these markings can be used for reference points. Place the blade on the sole of the boot at the center markings. Now move the front of the blade approximately one blade width towards the ball of the foot. Maintain the heel portion in the center.
- **3.** Using the pencil, mark the inside front screw hole at the toe of the blade. Then mark the opposite side screw hole at the back of the blade at the heel.
- **4.** Using a 3/32" drill bit, drill approximately half the depth of the mounting screw length.
- **5.** Most better grade skate blades will come packaged with 2 different length mounting screws. The shorter screws are to be used in the sole of the skate and the long screws are to be used in the heel.

- **6.** Insert the front screw in the hole that has been drilled and tighten. Position heel plate of blade in center and insert long screw and tighten.
- 7. Check blade for straightness and position.
- **8.** Now, using the oblong, slotted mounting holes in the sole plate of the blade, drill pilot hole in the center of the slotted hole and insert screw and tighten.
- **9.** Next, go back to the heel and drill pilot hole in the slotted hole in heel plate of the blade and insert screw and tighten.
- **10.** You should now have 3 screws mounted in the sole plate of the blade and 2 screws mounted in the heel plate of the blade. This is referred to as a temporary mount and will allow the skater to do light skating to determine proper blade position. If blade position needs to be adjusted after test skating, remove front toe screw and back heel screw. Release tension of the screws mounted in the slotted holes and adjust blade position as necessary.
- 11. Once blade position is determined, a more permanent mount should be done by drilling a pilot hole in remaining screw holes, insert screws and tighten. It is recommended to use no less than half of the mounting holes for a secure mounting of the blade to the boot.





SKATE SHARPENING

A properly sharpened skate blade can make the difference between a great performance, failed test session or simply just a fun day at the rink. For this reason, we encourage skaters to have their blades sharpened regularly by a trained and experienced skate sharpener. By doing so, you will be confident your skates will have a consistent edge.

Before having your skates sharpened, several factors should be taken in consideration so your blades can be sharpened to deliver the desired performance. Variables such as the size of the skater, type of skating being done, and the ice conditions of the rink need to be considered. Harder ice surfaces (17 – 19 degrees) can dull edges quicker and requires a deeper radius of hollow (ROH) and sharper edges. Softer ice conditions (20 -22 degrees) require a shallower ROH grind because blades can sink deeper in the ice surface.

General purpose ice skate blades are often sharpened with a shallower radius of hollow to prevent the edge from digging in too deep into the ice. A more advanced and higher-level skater typically has their blade sharpened with a deeper radius of hollow for better edge bite, speed and control.

Though most blades are manufactured with a predetermined radius of hollow, that does not restrict or limit the skater's individual options. The desired ROH should be determined by the skater's personal preference and their style of skating.

When a skate blade is sharpened, the hollow is ground into the length of the blade by an abrasive sharpening stone spinning a high revolution speed. The face of the sharpening stone is curved outward so when the blade contacts the stone, it grinds the metal away leaving a preset ROH.

The depth of hollow is an arc from an imaginary circle, which is measured by the length of its radius. A circle with a smaller radius forms a deeper curve and deeper hollow creating keener edges.

Knowing when to have your blade sharpened is usually something the skater will notice right away. When you start to slip on an edge, skid excessively into an entry of a jump or wash out on the landing of a jump, it's time to have your blades sharpened.

BOOT & BLADE CARE INSTRUCTIONS

SKATE CARE

A care guide comes with each new pair of skates. The care information is also available at ice.riedellskates.com. Your local authorized dealer can also answer questions about proper care and maintenance. The best thing you can do to care for skates is to reduce their exposure to moisture - both internal from perspiration, and external from the ice and snow. Be sure to open up and air dry your boots after each use. From time to time, you may polish your boots with quality shoe polish to reduce external moisture absorption. All leather soles should be waterproofed with 4-5 coats of Sno-seal Wax before initial use.

BLADE CARE

Your local authorized dealer can help answer questions about proper care and maintenance. Skating blades should be sharpened regularly by a professional skate technician. A sharp blade is a safe blade for skating. Always dry blades after skating to prevent rust and damage. Store skates with soft, cloth soakers or towels to wick moisture and protect the blade. Use skate guards when walking on hard surfaces to protect the blade. Dull or rusty blades will result in a skidding or slipping feeling when skating. If you see any rust, nicks, or experience slipping, your blades should be serviced by a professional.

LIMITED RESALE WARRANTY INFORMATION

WHO IS COVERED?

▶ This warranty is extended to all Authorized Riedell Dealers and the original end-use purchaser or the person receiving the product as a gift, and shall not be extended to any other person or transferee.

WHAT YOU MUST DO TO OBTAIN LIMITED WARRANTY SERVICE:

- Return product, with a copy of the original proof of purchase, Return authorization number and written description for why the product is being returned, using the following procedures:
- 1. Contact the Riedell organization in your country/region (visit riedellskates.com for Riedell contact information in your country/region) for a return authorization number and specific return/shipping instructions.
- 2. Label and ship the product, freight prepaid, to the address provided by the Riedell organization in your country/region.
- 3. Place any necessary return authorization number prominently on the outside of the shipping carton. Cartons not bearing a return authorization number, where required, will be refused.

WHAT IS COVERED/FOR HOW LONG?

All products manufactured by Riedell Shoes, Inc. are warranted by Riedell Shoes, Inc. to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal and intended use for a period of 6 months from the date of retail purchase by the original end-use purchaser. Eclipse® blades shall be warranted by Riedell Shoes, Inc. to be free from defects in material and workmanship, under normal and intended use for a period of 12 months from the date of retail purchase by the original end-use purchaser.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED?

This warranty does not cover product failure resulting from improper fit, accident, abuse, neglect or normal wear and tear, as determined by Riedell Shoes, Inc. Riedell Shoes, Inc. will not be responsible for the repair, replacement or consequential damage due to the above mentioned causes.

- ▶ This warranty does not cover post sale service costs, including but not limited to waterproofing of outsoles, blade sharpening and blade mounting.
- ▶ All rental products manufactured by Riedell Shoes, Inc. are excluded from this warranty and covered under a separate policy.

WHAT RIEDELL WILL DO:

- During the warranty period, Riedell Shoes, Inc. will, at our sole option, repair or replace any products determined to be defective within a reasonable period of time and free of charge. All repaired or replaced products under this policy shall be, at the discretion of the original end-use purchaser, returned to the original end-use purchaser or the authorized Riedell dealer from whom the product was purchased via ground service shipping at the expense of Riedell Shoes, Inc.
- Products returned that are not found to be defective or products returned beyond the warranty period that can be repaired, can be done so upon the approval of the authorized Riedell dealer or original end-use purchaser. Repair costs, including post sale services, will be provided to the authorized Riedell dealer or original end-use purchaser by Riedell Shoes, Inc. before any repair is made. Prior to any repair being made, Riedell Shoes, Inc. must receive authorization from the authorized Riedell dealer or original end-use purchaser as to all requested repairs. All freight expenses for such products, repairs and/or post sale services shall be the responsibility of the dealer or user.

For any claimed defective product, Riedell Shoes, Inc. will not be responsible for any inbound shipping, insurance or transportation charges, or any import fees, duties and taxes.
